THE PARENTS' AGREEMENT

As a parent, I commit to:

3. Provide my child with a quiet area to complete his school work.
4. Support the teacher and ensure the completion of all homework assignments and daily reading assignments.
5. Attend parent/teacher conferences as needed and assist with recommendations provided by school personnel.
6. Ensure my child respects all school property.
7. Supervise the amount of time my child spends watching television and monitor the quality of programs viewed.
8. Supervise the amount of time my child spends playing video games and monitor the quality of each.
9. Check my child's academic/behavior progress regularly by signing discipline and grade reports.
10. Teach my child to respect his/her teachers and school personnel.
11. Encourage daily reading.
12. Ensure that my child attends tutoring and Saturday Academy if necessary.
